Radiography program**

- **Application deadline: Jan 2, 2019 - May 15, 2019**
- Must be at college level Reading, English and Math and have pre-req for A&P I completed by end of Spring 2019 Semester. Which is: Gen. Biology I or Gen. Biology II or Gen. Chemistry, with a “C” or better. *Completion of A&P preferred*

Deficiencies in the areas of Reading, English and Mathematics as indicated by the Accuplacer are required to be remediated prior to admission to the Radiography program.

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 at time of applying
- HESI Admission Assessment Exam

Meeting all admission requirements does not guarantee admission into the program.

Information presented in this packet supersedes ALL other information obtained by the applicant.

Program Overview

Radiographers are health care professionals who use radiation (x-rays) to create medical images of the body. Other names used for the profession are: Radiologic Technologist or X-ray Technologist.

The career combines the use of modern medical equipment with patient interaction. Radiographers are valued members of the health care team and provide information to physicians so that patient's illnesses can be diagnosed and treatment initiated.

Radiographers find employment opportunities in hospitals, private imaging centers, health centers, and mobile imaging units. There are also opportunities in sales, marketing, research, education and industry.

The Radiography Program offers the education and clinical experience needed to enter this challenging and rewarding career.

Graduates of the Radiography Program may choose to continue their education and gain certification in an additional modality such as Ultrasound, Nuclear Medicine, MRI, Computed Tomography (CT), Radiation Therapy, Mammography, or Cardiac Catheterization. Educational requirements differ for each of those career paths. Additional information on advancement opportunities and salaries can be found on the American Society of Radiologic Technologists website, www.asrt.org under the "Career Center" link (see "Wage and Salary Guides").

In order to become a registered Radiographic Technologist, program graduates must pass a national exam given by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists. In the past five years, 96% (78/81) of graduates have passed the exam on the first try.

- Length – 24 months – 6 consecutive semesters
- Capacity – 22 first year students, based on clinical sites
- Begins – Fall semester (September) each year
- Tuition – established by Cumberland County College
- Clinical days / per week / per semester
 - 2 days – first semester (Fall)
 - 2 days – second semester (Spring)
 - 5 days – third semester (Summer 2)
 - 5 days – fourth semester (Summer 4)
 - 3 days – fifth semester (Fall)
 - 3 days – sixth semester (Spring)

Application Process

All selective admission programs at Cumberland County College have a unique, two-step application process that is necessary due to the College's open general admission policy. In order to be considered for admission to the nursing program, applicants must complete the first step for general admission to CCC. Once this is complete, the applicant may then proceed to the second step for selective admission to the nursing program. Be certain to distinguish between general admission and selective admission.

Both application processes must be completed correctly in order for your application to be considered for acceptance. Failure to do so will result in an incomplete activation packet.

STEP 1

General Admission

General Admission is the first step of application to the nursing program. This process will provide you with acceptance to the College, but not to the radiography program. If you are unsure of your application status or need an application, contact the Admissions Office at 856-691-8600 x1457.

1. Complete and submit a general admission application to the Admissions Office.
2. Submit an official copy of your high school transcript documenting high school graduation (or earned GED) to the Admissions Office.
3. If applicable, submit official transcripts from other colleges attended to the Admissions Office.
4. Complete Accuplacer testing (or provide SAT scores). Complete all required remediation.

STEP 2

Selective Admission

Once you have completed the general admission process, you are ready to begin the second step in the application process: submission of your activation packet. Each applicant is required to gather all documentation listed on the checklist and present it to the Radiography Department as a completed packet.

The packets consists of:

1. Activation packet checklist
2. Radiography Activation form
3. HESI Scores (results valid for 2 years)
4. 2018-19 Information Session Attendance Slip (Obtained at MANDATORY Information Session)
5. Official transcript from high school (If applicable) (MUST be in sealed envelope)
6. Official transcripts from ALL colleges attended other than CCC (MUST be in sealed envelope)

Individuals applying to the program should have a scholastic background which includes high school algebra, biology and chemistry. Those applicants lacking the scholastic background, or returning to school after a prolonged absence, are able to fulfill the entrance requirements through participation in college courses.

**Acceptance is limited and based on the HESI Exam and academic history.*

Students accepted to the Radiography program must be in good health and able to meet the physical demands of the career as evidenced by the results of a complete physical examination documented by the applicant's physician. Complete acceptance to the Radiography program is contingent upon the submission of the completed medical form, including drug testing, and successful completion of a criminal background check. The Medical Form and additional information regarding the background check will be provided to the student following the acceptance letter.

Applicants are encouraged to review all policies specific to the radiography program. Program policies addressing student

health, essential functions, pregnancy, and program progression and retention are published in the radiography program student handbook. Copies of the Radiography Student Handbook are available for download from this Webpage.
